 - o Name

Age 7

- Review first two parts of the Holy Quran
- Wudhu
 - o Prayer when performing ablution
 - o Demonstrate to parents and local secretaries
- Hadith
 - o Not Abusing other Muslims
- Poems
 - o *Quran Sab Se Acha* (1st couplet)

Age 8

- Recite 11th part of Holy Quran
 - o Reading Quran and learning different words

- Salat w/ translation

Age 10

- Studying the translation for Surah Al-Baqarahruku 1-4
- First four verses of Surah Al-Baqarah (this week)
 - o In the name of Allah the Gracious the Merciful
 - o AlifLaamMeem = Ana AllahuA’alamu: I am Allah the All-Knowing
 - o This is a perfect book, there is no doubt in it, it is a guidance for the righteous.
 - o Who believe in the unseen and observe prayer and spend out what We have provided for them.
 - Al-ghaib: غاب – he became invisible or hidden; anything absent or far away
 - Yuqeemoon: اقام – he stood erect; he stood up; “Iqaam as-Salat” : he performed prayer
 - Razaqnaahum: رزق – he provided for them, gave an advantage
 - Yunfiqoon: انفق king reduced his wealth
- Prayers with translation
 - o Starting a meal: *bismillahiwaalaabarakatillah*

- Finishing a meal:
alhamdulillahilatheeat'amanaawasaqanaawa'jalana min-al muslimeen
- Apply these prayers and learn the translation
- Hadith (word-by-word translation)
 - *Inna mal a'amaalubinniyyaat* with translation
- Poem
 - *KabhiNusratNahinMilti*
- Attributes of Allah
 - *RabbulAlameen*– Lord of all the worlds (Surah Al-Fatiha)
 - Vastness of all the worlds
 - Limitlessness of our universe
 - Our astronomical instruments to study our universe
 - Telescopes
 - Satellites
 - Cameras
 - Beyond what we've studied
 - We cannot imagine the size of our universe; yet to be discovered
 - Parallels the limitless capacity of Allah Ta'ala: He covers all the areas that we can think about and beyond
 - HadhratMasihMa'ood AS's commentary of Surah Al-Fatiha
- Etiquette
 - Salat
 - Perform Wudhu
 - Reach place of worship carefully
 - Do not run to Salat even if you are late
 - Contemplate on the goodness and piety
 - You are talking to God
 - Respond to the call of nature beforehand so you can be attentive
 - Standing shoulder-to-shoulder with no gaps
 - Mosque

 - Childhood of Holy Prophet SAW
 - *RasoolePaakkeBachpa*
- Personal data
 - Putting together your folder
 - Vaccination
 - Certificates from school (K-4)
 - Report cards

Age 11-12

- Quran
 - Commentary of first four verses of Surah Al-Baqarah
 - Tafseer-e-Kabeer
- Poem
 - *Ham Ahmadi Bache Hen*
- Hadith
 - *Al Majaalisubilamaanah* – the meetings are a matter of importance of trust
- Attribute of Allah
 - *Al-Ghafoor* – The Most Forgiving
 - Friday sermons by KhalifatulMasih V ABA (in archives on alislam.org)
 - How Allah is the Most Forgiving shows the weakness of man; so should say it in our prayers
 - Allah’s most “inviting” attribute when we submit ourselves to Him
- Prayers that we learn, if we add Allah’s attributes, they become more appealing
 - *Rabbi inniilimaanzalatailayya...*
 - *Allahummainnia’uzubika...*
 - *Rabbanalaatuzighquloobana...*
 - *Rabbanaafrighalainaasabran...*

Saed Soud Ahmad Sahib (14-17)

Age 14

- Quran
 - Part 5 An-Nisa:25 "*Wa-lmuhsanaat...*"
 - Stopping at ط and ج
 - Tanween: حكيماً
 - *Alaikum*, on you
 - *Walmuhanaat*: who are married
 - *Min-nisaa*: from the women
 - *Malakat*: possession; custody, under your protection, during wars women who have lost their homes; need your protection
 - Recognize them as a citizen and individual
 - Married women are not for you, they are only under your custody
 - You can get married to the other women
 - Avoiding fornication and should marry them properly
 - Have to treat them properly; not for pleasure, but to get married
 - Homework: go over the translation and commentary for these verses
 - Ending day with Quran and prayers, then sleep.
- Prayer
 - Entering the graveyard
 - *Assalamualaikumyaahlulqubooriyaghfirullahlanaawalakumant umsa'alfunaawanahnubilathriwainnainshaAllahubikumlalahifi qoon*
 - Peace be upon you O dwellers of the graves. May Allah grant forgiveness to us and to you as well. You are there before us and we will follow you and by Allah's Will, we shall meet.
- Hadith
 - 40 Gems of Beauty
 - The best way to memorize is through rhyme so put them into poems
 - Ahadith
 - Sunnah
 - Companions who narrated

- Those who met the companions
- Those who met the above people
- Different types, collections of ahadith
- Homework: read introduction
- Etiquette
 - Conversation
 - Look at the example of the Holy Prophet SAW, the Promised Messiah AS, and our Khulafa
 - Make sure what you see is understandable
 - Talk wisely
 - Talk in a way that the other person can understand
 - To elders: with respect
 - To younger: with kindness
 - Don't use foul language
 - Pay full attention
 - No absurd talking
 - In a way that can help others
