Imran Jattala Sahib - Age group 4-7:

- Learn the names of Salaat
- Learn how to perform wudhu
- The five daily prayers and their respective times:
 - Fajr: right before sunrise
 - Zuhr: immediately after the sun has reached its' zenith; during midday
 - Asr: between midday and sunset
 - Maghrib: after the sunsets
 - Isha: mid evening prayers (hour after Maghrib) prayers
- This week, please observe your parents performing salaah and observe the various positions.
- During this month, two lessons of Yassarnal Quran must be completed. This Learning of the Yassarnal Quran takes place at home. Lesson one should be completed within two weeks, and lesson two should begin after next weeks class
- Wudhu:
 - Wash your hands, nose, face, both arms, wetting of the hands over the head and you're the ears, and finally feet

- Please observe your parents performing wudhu and see the various steps that are done in its' completion.
- Prayer for parents: Rabir hum humaa kamaa Rabba yani saghira
- Next week, we will go over surah fatiha. As a starter, please go over this surah during this week.

Age Group Six:

Age group 7-8

- Begin participating in auxiliaries of Jamaat such as Atfal-ul-Ahmadiyya and Nasirartul Ahmadiyya for the girls.
- The young boys who live close to the masjid should try their best to attend at least one congregational prayer.
- The first two parts of the Holy Quran should be studied. One part should be studied for about two weeks.
- One rukoo per day, seven per week
- Read the first six verses of Surah Al-Baqarah (In class)
- The class went over the correct recitation of this verse, e.g., correct way in pronouncing words that need to be prolonged.
- The class learned about the prayer after wudhu (Arabic and translation).
- Poem should be memorized: *Quran Sabsai Acha, Quran sabse Pyaara.*
- Homework: memorize attribute of Allah rabul-alameen. Write this on a big piece of paper and send an email confirming you have done this.

Age group 8-9

- Went over the Holy Quran part 11 verse 7&8 (Arabic)
- Went over the correct way to pronounce several words
- Went over the six articles of belief.
- Homework: Memorize the the attribute of Allah As-Salaam. Write this on a big piece of paper and send an email confirming you have done this.

Lutful Mannan Sahib (Age 10-14)

Age 10-11

- Went over the hadith “deeds are judged by motives.”
- Went over the hadith “people are like a teeth of a comb.”

Age 11-12

- Went over the early life of Holy Prophet (saw)
- Mentioned over the book: “Life of Muhammad”
- Mentioned over the book: “Muhammad, seal of the prophets.”
- Attribute of Allah: Al Gafoor (the great forgiver)
- Children in this age group should start learning Holy Quran with translation

Age 12-13

- Understand the translation of selected verses word by word translation.
- Learn the first half translation of Surah Al-Baqarah
- Memorize the three verses of Surah Al-Imran (126-128)
- Hadith: “The upper hand is better than the lower hand.”

Saed Saud Sahib (Age 15+)

- Prayer for entering the graveyard (Arabic and translation)
- Hadith: “poverty may well turn to disbelief”

Age 15

- Read the prayer: Rabighfir warhum wa anta khairl rahimeen
- Hadith: “Salaat is a pillar of Faith”

Age 16

- Went over chapter 3, verse 9
- Hadith: “there is a natural love towards a benefactor...”
- The class went over the Ashra Mubashara
- Went over Imam Jurisprudence
- Children should read humarai Aqaa
- Children should also read Khatam Nabiyeen

The class went over two conditions of ba’ait:

That he/she shall abstain from Shirk (association of any partner with God) right up to the day of his/her death.

That he/she shall keep away from falsehood, fornication, adultery, trespasses of the eye, debauchery, dissipation, cruelty, dishonesty, mischief and rebellion; and will not permit himself / herself to be carried away by passions, however strong they might be.
