Imran Jattala Sahib - Age group 4-7:

The class went over the beginning parts of Salaat, which included audio clips of Sanaa and Atuawuz. The class will go over rukoos 2-3 of Surah Al-Baqarah in

this month. Please try to do this on your own as well because of the time constraints of the class.

The class will go over Adhaan in this month. The class listened to an audio clip of adhaan for memorization as well as correct pronunciation.

The class went over various Salaat terminologies such as Rakaat, Rukoo, Vitr, etc. The class also went over the names of the physical positions of Salaat.

Children of Age group Six should finish learning the names of family names such as grandparents in this month.

- Salat
 - Thanaa and Ta'wuz
 - Thanaa: *Subhanakallahummawabihamdikawatabaaraka-smukawata'aalajaddukawalaailaahaghairuk*: Holy are You O Allah the Praiseworthy and Blessed is Your Name and Exalted is Your Majesty and there is none worthy of worship besides You
 - Ta'wuz: *A'uzubillahi mina-shaitaani-rajeem*: I seek refuge with Allah from Satan the rejected
 - Etiquettes
 - Timings

- **Age 5 - 6**

- Holy Quran: Part 2 Ruku 2-3
- **Homework for the month: Adhaan**
- Last week: someone can present adhaan in the class

- **Age 6 - 7**

- Holy Quran: review Yassarnal Quran
- Salat

- Number of **Rakaat** (from raising hands to ears or standing from prostration until the second prostration or sitting for Atahiyyaat)
 - Fajr: 2 rakaat**Sunnah** (from the practice of the Holy Prophet^{SAW}) and 2 rakaat**Fardh** (Allah has prescribed for the prayer; obligatory, in congregation)
 - Zuhr: 4 rakaat**Sunnah**, 4 rakaat**Fardh** (the Imam does not recite the Salat aloud), 2 rakaat**Sunnah**, 2 rakaat**Nafl** (completely optional)
 - Asr: 4 rakaat**Fardh** (the Imam does not recite the Salat aloud)
 - Maghrib: 3 rakaat**Fardh**, 2 rakaat**Sunnah**, 2 rakaat**Nafl**
 - Isha: 4 rakaat **Fardh**, 2 rakaat **Sunnah**, 3 rakaat **Witr** (can also be offered with the Tahajjud), 2 rakaat **Nafl**
- Parents' names and grandparents' names

Dr. Chairul Bhari Sahib.(Age 7-10)

The class will cover the third part of Surah Al-Baqarah which begins on verse 254. This part will be covered in this month.

Dr. Chairul Bhari sahibs read verse 254 of Surah Al-Baqarah for reading as well as correct pronunciation.

In this month, children will continue learning "Quran Subse Acha Aquran Sabse Pyarra." The class will go over the second verse of this poem.

Waqfe Nau boys and girls who are Atfal/Nasirat should fully participate in their respective axillaries' activities/classes/meetings. The Waqfe Nau boys need to memorize the Pledge for Majlis Atfaul Ahmadiyya. The girls need to memorize the pledge for Nasiratul Ahmadiyya.

Children learned the etiquettes of going to the mosque from before coming to the mosque as well as etiquettes in the mosque. The children learned the prayer for entering a mosque.

The children read Part 12, Verse 7 of Surah Hud for reading as well as correct pronunciation.

The class went over "Sanaa" in Salaat.

Children are expected to memorize the first 6 verses of Surah Al-Baqarah during the first six months this class. The class has already memorized the first two verses and learned the third verse today.

- Age 7 - 9

- Holy Quran – first half of part (also known as juz, or parah) 3 in the reading
 - Surah Al-Baqarah verse 254
 - Pay attention to the mads the elongation of the words
 - The word “Allah” – according to Arabic, if the word “Allah” is preceded by a fatha the “a” sound our dhomma the “u” sound, then the “ll” is thick; if Allah is preceded by a kasra “i” sound, then the “ll” is thin
- Poem – Quran sab se acha - **memorize the second verse**
- Atfal and Nasirat Pledge in the Waqf-e-Nau syllabus **memorize the pledge**
- Etiquettes of the mosque
 - Physically clean and the mind is clean
 - Enter with the right foot and recite the prayer for entering the mosque: *Bismillahi-salaatuwa-salaamu*
'alaarasoolillahiallahumma-
ghfirleethunoobiwaftahliabwaabirahmatik

- Age 8 - 9

- Holy Quran – complete part 12 in the reading
 - The word “Allah”
 - SurahHud verse 9
 - Important words:
 - *akharnaa* – We put off; We delay
 - *ummati*– people; time in this verse
 - **Memorize first 5 verses of Surah Al-Baqarah**
- Salat review
 - **Thanaa with translation** – after the first *Allahu Akbar*

- **Age 8 - 9**

The class went over verses 8-9 of Surah Al-Baqarah. The class also went over the word-by-word translation for these months.

- Holy Quran
 - Surah Al-Baqarah verses 8-9
 - Begin learning the translation
 - *Khatamallahu* : Allah has set a seal
 - *Quloob*: hearts
 - *Sam'ihim*: their ears
 - *'athaab*: punishment
 - *'azeem*: great
 - "Them" the disbelievers
 - *Yaum* – day
 - *Aakhir*– last
 - *Maa*– not

Lutful Mannan Sahib (Age 10-14)

- **Age 10-11**

The class went reviews quickly the topics they have learned ranging from the Holy Quran, Islamic History, Ahadith to attributes of Allah. The class went over the attribute of Al-Rahman, "The Gracious." Children need to observe 5 days of fasting in the month of Ramadhan.

- Remember to review
- Attributes of Allah
 - *Rabbul 'alameen*
 - *Ar-Rahmaan*
- Go to the archives of Huzoor's Friday Sermons
- Observe 5 days of fasting during Ramadan

- History: Life of the Holy Prophet SAW
- Hadith: on trust
- **Age 11-12**

The class recapped some of the topics that it had covered in past few weeks.

- o *almustashaarumu'taman*

- **Age 12-13**

The class went over the three verses (285-287?) of Surah Al-Baqarah. Please memorize these verses as well as contacting us and letting the class know you are keeping up to date.

The class went over the Hadith that states: "the upper hand is better than the lower hand" as well as "the hand that gives is better than the hand receives." The class also quickly went over hadith pertaining to this topic of idleness/begging.

The class needs to go over the first ½ of Surah Al-Baqarah with Translation of the Holy Quran. This is an independent assignment which must be done outside of this class due to time constraints.

The class went over a poem of Kalaam-e-Mahmood that should be memorized.

The class was asked to read the life of Holy Prophet Muhammad (saw) and was prescribed several references for understanding.

- o Surah Ali-Imran verses 26-28 (send an e-mail to let us know once you have memorized it)
- o Hadith: "The upper hand is better than the lower hand"
 - Traveling to the mountain is better than waiting for something to happen
 - Make an honest earning
- o Review first half of the first part with translation
- o Poem: *Kilaam-e-Mahmood: Men apkepyaaroankinisbat*
- o Life of the Holy Prophet SAW
 - Read Life of Muhammad^{SAW}; Muhammad Seal of Prophets

- Review Attributes of Allah
- Etiquettes of Salat and Mosque, etiquettes of the home
 - Relating to ahadith and why these are required

- Age 13-14

The class needs to go over ¼ of Surah Al-Baqarah with translation.

The class learned of saying salutations of peace to other people. This applies to when a person enters a mosque, home, etc. Quranic references as well hadith references were given for deeper understanding of this topic.

- Holy Quran: [learn a quarter of chapter 2 with translation](#)
- [Hadith: Abshusalambainakum – Promote greetings of peace to each other](#)
 - From Surah An-Nur – greet your people with salutations of peace (24:62)
 - When you are greeted with a salutation then respond with a better greeting or the same (4:87)
 - Importance of saying: Assalamualaikum

Saed Saud Sahib (Age 15+)

- Age 14 (4:47-56)

The class went over (in-depth) Surah Nisa, verses 47-57 for translation and understanding. The class focused on several words for further understanding.

- Ra'inaa – calling someone in a derogatory manner (Hey, come here!)
- Unzurnaa – calling someone with respect (Excuse me)
- *Nazeera* – on a date stone
- *Bi jahannama* - Hell
- *Sa'eera* – blazing fire

- Age 15 (7:123-140)

The class went over Surah Al-Araf, Chapter 7 verses 123-140 for translation and understanding. The topic pertains to the time of Hadhrat (as) Musa and with the Israelites.

- Story of HadhratMusa^{AS} and Pharoah
- Persecution in the name of law
 - Quotations from Pharoah
- *Al toofaan* – the storm
- *Al jaraad* – the locusts
- *Al qumul*- the lice
- *Al dhufaadi'a*– the frogs

- Age 16 (12:67-95)

The class went over Surah Yusuf chapter 12 verses 67-95 for translation and understanding. This topic highlights the famous story of Hadhrat Yusuf (as) and his relation with his brothers. This is a very interesting topic and is recommended that the class reads this topic on their own as well.

- Story of Hadhrat Yusuf^{AS} when his brothers are bringing the youngest brother, Benjamin, to Hadhrat Yusuf
- Verse 93: same quote on how the Holy Prophet^{SAW} should treat the Meccan chiefs
