Imran Jattala Sahib - Age group 4-7:

Age 4-7

- Adhaan – the Muslim call to prayer (4 and 5 years)
 - Should stop everything and go to the mosque
 - Muedhin – caller to adhaan
 - Facing the Ka’aba
 - Fingers in his ears
 - Call adhaan in a loud voice
 - Head turns to the right when saying: *hae ‘alas salaah*
 - Head turns to the left when saying: *hae ‘alfalaah*
 - Adhaan with translation
 - During adhaan for Fajr prayer should say: *As-Salatukhairu-minan-naum*– prayer is better than sleep – twice after *hae ‘alfalaah*
 - Adhaan is called for every Salat: Fajr, Zuhr, Asr, Maghrib, and Isha
- Salat review (4 and 5 years)
 - Fajr – before sunrise
 - Zuhr – immediately after zenith
 - Asr – between Zuhr and sunset; late afternoon
 - Maghrib – immediately after sunset
 - Isha – late evening prayer
 - Rakaat – sequence of postures
 - In first rakaat rise after second prostration
 - In second rakaat
 - If offering only two – recite DaroodShareefIbrahimi
 - If offering more than two – rise after *Ashhaduallailaaha...*
 - If only three rakaat – sit down and recite daroodshareef

- If four rakaat – rise in the third rakaat after second prostration and recite daroodshareef in the fourth

Dr. Chairul Bhari Sahib.(Age 7-10)

Age 7

- Quran
 - Saying the word Allah review: if the word “Allah” is preceded by a fatha the “a” sound our dhomma the “u” sound, then the “ll” is thick; if Allah is preceded by a kasra “i” sound, then the “ll” is thin
 - 7-8 – recite first half of part 3 2:255
 - Pay attention to the elongations
- Atfal-ul-Ahamdiyya and Nasirat-ul-Ahmadiyya
 - Memorize pledge
 - *Asshhaduallailaahailallahuwahdahulaashareekalahuwaasshhaduann amuhammadan ‘abduhuwarasooluh (3x)*
 - Atfal – I bear witness that there is no God but Allah, the One without any partner and I bear witness that Muhammad is His servant and His messenger. I solemnly pledge – that I shall

always be ready to serve Islam, Ahmadiyyat, the nation and the country. I shall always speak the truth. I shall not abuse anybody. And I shall strive to obey all the commandments of KahlifatulMasih. Inshallah.

- Nasirat - I bear witness that there is no God but Allah, the One without any partner and I bear witness that Muhammad is His servant and His messenger. I solemnly promise that I shall always keep myself ready to serve Islam, my nation, and my country and shall always adhere to the truth. Inshallah.

Age 9

- Quran

- Understand 2:8-9

- Characteristics of disbelievers and hypocrites

- Basic religious knowledge

- 6 articles of faith
 - Belief in Allah
 - Belief in the Angels of Allah
 - Belief in the Books of Allah
 - Belief in the Messengers of Allah
 - Belief in Last Day

- Belief in the Decree of Allah
- Belief in Allah
 - *Asmaa-ul-Husnaa* – attributes of Allah; over 100 attributes
- Belief in Angels of Allah
 - *Malak* – energy, follows the commands of God
 - *Jibreel* – Gabriel – brings the revelation of God to His messengers
 - *Mikaal* – Michael – deals with worldly affairs
 - We believe in angels with the spiritual sense, they are not the ones in fairy tales and folklores
 - The Promised Messiah^{AS} has warned us not to abandon the belief of angels (since the majority have turned to worldly pursuits)
- Belief in the Books of Allah – Divine Law
 - Books
 - Torah
 - Holy Quran – last book to the Holy Prophet^{SAW}; as complete guidance for all mankind

Lutful Mannan Sahib (Age 10-14)

- Quran
 - Surah Al-Baqarah verses 5-7
 - *Unzila* – that has been revealed; *nazala* – send down; anything bestowed by God to man
 - *Aakhira* – what is yet to come; *akhara* – later one
 - *Yooqinoon* – certainty
 - *Al-muflihoon* – those who shall prosper; *falaha* – success that others may envy, everyone wants the same success
 - *Kafaroo*– they disbelieve; *kafara* opposite of *aamana*; those who deny faith

- *Anzartahum* – whether thou warn them; *anzar* – to warn
 - Memorizing Surah Al-Asr and translation
- Salat
 - Ar-Ra’ad:29 – remembrance of Allah; true comfort
- Early life of the Holy Prophet^{SAW}
 - When he was 4, under the care of Haleema, when he was playing outside of the house and Hadhrat Jibraeel came. He cut open his chest and took his heart and removed the impurities.
 - This was only seen by the children around him and they were scared
 - This was another *kishf* – not seen by the normal eye

Age 11-12

- Hadith
 - A person who sincerely repents his sins is like the one who has never sinned.
- Attributes of Allah
 - Oft-Returning with Compassion
- Prayer
 - **Entering the home** - O Allah I supplicate to You the best of entries to my house and the best of exits, and to Allah we put our complete trust.

Age 12-13

- Biography of Hadhrat Masih Ma’ood^{AS}
 - Family background
 - Birth and childhood
 - First marriage
 - His religious interest even early on in his life

Age 13-14

- Hadith
 - Cleanliness is a requirement of faith
 - Self and surroundings

- Attributes of Allah
 - Al-Khaaliq – The Creator
 - Al-Baari – The Maker

Saed Saud Sahib (Age 15+)

Age 14 – 15

- 4:92-103
 - Referring to those who disturb the peace
 - *Rakabatinmu'minatin* – believing slave
 - *Yajiz*– to find
 - *Fasiyaamu*– fasting
 - *Shahara*– one month
 - *Muta'abiaini*– consecutive
 - *Ghaziballahu*– Allah's wrath
 - Do not simply attack the enemy
 - *Fatabayyanu* - investigate
 - *Tabtaghoona* – seeking
 - *Maghaanimu* – favors
 - *Katheeran* – abundance
 - Action is better than thinking
 - *Dharari* – disabled
 - *Qaaideena* – those who sit
 - *Malaaikatu* – angels
 - *Yakhruju* – leave
 - *Muraaghaman* – place of refuge
 - *Yutriku* – overtake them
 - *Dharabtum* – you travel

- 7:165-172

- *Mu'athibahum* – punish them
 - *Qirada*– apes
 - *Khasieen*– despised
 - *'atau*– exceeded
 - *yab'athna*– raise
 - *'iqaab*– retribution
 - *ghafoor*– Most Forgiving
 - *saalihoon*– the righteous
 - *hasanaati*– the good
 - *sayyiaati*– the bad
 - *jabala*– mountain
