 - Age 4
 - Thanaa
 - Salat times
 - Age 5
 - Adhaan
 - Age 6
 - Number of rakaat
 - Niyyah – intention of prayer; be aware of which prayer you are reading; essential to build an intention one your mind
 - Thanaa – after Niyyah
 - Ta’wuz – *A’uzubillahi mina-shshaitaani-rajeem* – I seek refuge with Allah from the accursed Satan
 - Recap
 1. Do Wudhu
 2. Step onto the prayer mat, facing the Ka’aba
 3. Have the intention for reading prayers
 4. Allahu Akbar: raise hands to ears then fold arms in front of chest
 5. Recite the words for the Niyyah prayer
 6. Recite the words for Thanaa
 7. Recite Ta’wuz
 - Timings
 - Fajr – before sun is up; 2 Sunnah, 2 Fardh
 - Zuhr – immediately after zenith; 4 Sunnah, 4 Fardh, 2 Sunnah, 2 Nafl
 - Asr – late afternoon; 4 Fardh
 - Maghrib – immediately after sunset; 3 Fardh, 2 Sunnah, 2 Nafl
 - Isha – late evening; 4 Fardh, 2 Sunnah, 3 Witr, 2 Nafl

- Salat cannot be offered when:
 - Sun is rising
 - Sun is at zenith – right above the head
 - Sun is setting

 - 2 Important words
 - *fala'allaka*
 - *fa* – then

- *la'alla* – in order to

 - *kanzun*– treasure
 - **Surah Al-Baqarah 2:1-3 memorized**
- Salat-Thanaa

Age 9

- **Do'aQunoot**
 - Normally and preferably read in the third rakaat of Witr prayer
- 6 Articles of Faith
 - Belief in Allah
 - Belief in the Angels
 - Jibraeel/Gabriel (mentioned in the Holy Quran by name)
 - Mikaeel/Michael (mentioned in the Holy Quran by name)
 - Israeel – for the death
 - Israfeel – make an announcement about the Day of Resurrection
 - Belief in the Books of Allah
 - Belief in the Prophets of Allah
 - Belief in the Last Day
 - Belief in the Decree of Allah

Lutful Mannan Sahib (Age 10-14)

- Review from previous lesson
 - Ages 10-11: 2:5-7
 - Etiquettes of Mosque
 - Early Life of Holy Prophet^{SAW}
 - Hadith (Ages 11-12): Repentance of Sin

- Attributes of Allah
- Early Life of Hadhrat Masih Ma'ood^{AS} (please send your feedback)
- Etiquettes of Mosque
 - Enter in the mosque with the right foot first and recite the prayer:
 - *Bismillahi-salaatuwassalamu 'alaarasoolillahi... rahmatik*
 - Exit the mosque and recite the prayer
 - *Bismillahi-salaatuwassalamu 'alaarasoolillahi... fadhlik*
 - Practice these prayers
 - The front row should be occupied first
- Early Life of Holy Prophet^{SAW}
 - His relatives
 - Sons of Hadhrat Abdul Muttalib (his grandfather)
 - Haaris
 - Zubair
 - Abu-Talib
 - Hamza
 - Abu-Lahab
 - Abbas
 - Abdullah (his father)
 - Abu-Talib and Abdullah were from the same mother
 - Age 12: He and Abu Talib were going on a trade mission to Syria. When the caravan was passing through a city called Busra, a priest noticed that the trees and the stones prostrated. He knew that one among the caravan would become a prophet and he told Abu Talib to take care of the young Holy Prophet^{SAW}.
- Life of Holy Prophet^{SAW} Before Prophethood (Age 11-12)
 - Zubair revived an agreement to the leaders of Quraish. The Holy Prophet SAW was also active in this agreement that promoted justice and help those who are underprivileged and weak.
