Visitors are returning often and benefiting from this resource. By the sheer grace of Allah listeners from as far away as London, Canada and Qadian, India have been tuning in.
 - o Urdu learning workbooks are available for download on www.waqfenau.us. While these workbooks are not Jamaat books, their sole purpose for usage is for learning Urdu.
 - o Also on the Urdu page of www.waqfenau.us there are Urdu Jamaat books that needed as a part of the Waqfe Nau Syllabus.

- Waqfe Nau USA website has a 24-Hour video stream of programs that relate to Waqfe Nau children.

Imran Jattala Sahib - Age group 4-7:

This is the second week of Month two of the Waqfe Nau Class Syllabus.

- The class went over audio clips that pertain to Adhaan and Salaat. The clips describe Adhaan and the next clips would introduce Salaat in general and Iqamaat, Niyyat Atawuz and Sanaah in particular. The Arabic was presented of Adhaan/Salaat as well as Urdu/English Translation. These clips are very informative and are available on www.alislam.org.
- The Adhaan clip details the preparation for Salaat as well as the correct pronunciation of Adhaan. The class also learned the variation of Adhaan during Salatul Fajr time. In this time, the phrase “Assalatu khairum minnum Naum” is said after Haya Alasalla....Haya Allul-Falah”
- The Salaat clip gave a general description of Salaat, as well as the timings of the five daily prayers.
- The *Iqaamah/Niyyah* clip gave an understanding of what *Iqamaah/Niyyah* are and how they are said and correctly pronounced.
- The Sanaah/tawwuz clip gave understanding of Sanaah/Atawwuz as well as correct pronunciation.
- Inshallah next week, the class will go over Surah Al-Fathia (which is for age group 4)
- Children should be able to recognize the pictures of Hadhrat Promised Messiah (as) as well as the Khalifa’s.
- Children should know the names of their family members, especially their grandparents.
- In this month (3rd month), the class is going over Lesson number 3 of Yassarnal Quran (Age group 4)
- In this month children are going over rukoos 2/3 of Surah Al-Baqarah (Age group 5)

- In this month, age group six is going over a review of the Yassarnal Quran. (Age group 6)
- Adhaan
- Recognize pictures of Promised Messiah^{AS} as well as his Khulafa
- Know the names of grandparents on both sides
- Yassarnal Quran Lesson 3

Dr. Chairul Bhari Sahib.(Age 7-10)

Age group 7

- The class went over Surah Al-Baqarah Verse 257. Dr. Sahib carefully went over specific words such as Allah and described how to pronounce this word within the context of this verse.
- The children in this age group need to memorize the second verse of “Quran Sabse Acha, Quran Sabse Pyarra”
- The children need to go over their respective auxiliaries” (Majlis Atfal-ul-Ahmadiyya and Nasiratul Ahmadiyya) pledge. The children should try and memorize this pledge as well as participate in these auxiliaries” events.
- The children need to know (as of today) the prayer to enter the Mosque as well as knowing the etiquettes of the Mosque. The class went over this prayer in Arabic and English translation.

Age Group 8

- In this month, children should complete the reading of the twelfth part of the Holy Quran. The class went over Surah Hud verse 14-15 with the correct Arabic recitation.

- The children in this age group reviewed Sanaah with the correct way to pronounce the Arabic words.
- The children need to memorize the third verse of Surah Al-Baqarah in this month of the class syllabus. In total, the children need to memorize the first 5 verses of the Holy Quran by the end of the six month of instruction

Age Group 9

- Children in this age group need to review verses 8-9 of Surah Al Baqarah with translation/commentary.
- The class went over Dua Quanooot with the Arabic text recited first as well as the English translation.
- Children in this age group need to know the six articles of Eemaan “faith”
 - Believe in the Oneness of God
 - Believe in the Angels of Allah
 - Believe in the Books of Allah
 - Believe in the Prophets of Allah
 - Believe in the Divine Decree
 - Believe in the Day of Judgment
- The class specifically went over the Books of Allah, Prophets of Allah, Divine Decree, and the Day of Judgement.

Lutful Mannan Sahib (Age 10-14)

Age group 10-12

- The children in this age group need to have gone through the first seven verses of Surah Al-Baqarah

- Children are asked to memorize Surah Al-Asr as well as its translation. The class went over this Surah, its Arabic text, English translation and its commentary as well.
- The class went over the Linage of Hadrat Muhammad (saw) as for a better understanding of the History of Islam. The class focused on both Hadrats Abdullah and Hadrats Amina as well.

Age Group 13-14

- The class went over the names of Allah as well as understanding why the attributes of Allah are so important. Manan Sahib mentioned that there is a relationship between the names of Allah and seeking prayers and blessing from Allah. In particular, the class went over Al-Mussawir (the fashioner) and Al-Khair (bounty/the goodness/well being).
- The class learned about the biography of Hadrat Abu Bakr (ra). Please re-listen to Lutful Manan Sahib's detailed review on the important life of Hadrat Ab Bakr (ra).

Saed Saud Sahib (Age 15+)

Age group 14

- The class went over Surah Nisa, verse 115-133 of the Holy Quran. The class went over the translation of these verses and paid particular attention to several words for further understanding. Please re-listen to Saed Saud Sahib's lecture once again for full notes and further understanding. MashAllah at some verses, Saed Saud Sahib stated that the class went over all these Arabic words and the class knows the meaning! Saed Saud Sahib's lectures are a wonderful way to learn Arabic by simple word meanings in specific contexts.

Age Group 15

- The class went over Surah Al-Araf verse 186-208. The class went over the translation of these verses and paid particular attention to several words for

further understanding. Please re-listen to Saed Saud Sahib's lecture once again for full notes and further understanding.

Age Group 16
