Imran Jattala Sahib - Age group 4-7:

Quran:

- Age 4: Yassarnal Quran Lessons 4-6
- Age 5: Quran: Ruku 4-5 of Surah Al-Baqarah
- Should be recited daily regardless of what's going on
- Age 6: Review first half of the Holy Quran

Salat:

- Age 5: Adhaan – listened to a recording of the adhaan and its method
- Children should be encouraged to call the adhaan at the masjid and at home
- Listened to a recording of *Introduction to Salat* in English and Urdu
 - Should face the Ka'aba
 - 5 obligatory prayers in a day called Fardh
 - Fajr: when dawn ends, just before sunrise
 - Zuhr: right when the sun passes its zenith
 - Asr: when the sun has gone almost halfway through its zenith and towards sunset, can be called late afternoon
 - Maghrib: immediately after sunset
 - Isha: when it is completely dark
 - A unit of Salat is called Rakaat containing:
 - Standing: Qiyaam
 - Bowing down: Ruku
 - Standing with hands on the side: Qaama
 - Prostration: Sajdah (2 in one rakaat)
 - Sitting between two prostrations: Jasdah
 - Sitting after the second prostration: Qa'ada

Prayers:

- **Prayer for Entering the Mosque**
 - *Bismillahi-salaaatu was-salaamu 'alaarasoolillahiallahumma-ftahleeabwaabrahamatik*: on page 15 of the NisabWaqf-e-Nau English version -

- Prayer for going to sleep (Age 6)

- Age 6: be familiar with the names of Khulafa-e-Ahmadiyya
- Be familiar of the names of grandparents
- Age 5: memorize the names of:
 - o Holy Prophet SAW
 - Holy Prophet Muhammad SAW
 - o Khulafa-e-Rashiddeen
 - Hadhrat Abu Bakr RA
 - HadhratUmarFarooq RA
 - HadhratUsmanGhani RA
 - Hadhrat Ali RA

Dr. Chairul Bhari Sahib.(Age 7-10)

Age group 7

Age 7:

- Quran: second half of the third part
- Practice reading the Quran with pointing with your finger
- Qiraat: "Al" - many words are preceded with "al" with ا ل
- Hadith: *Sibaabulmuslimfusooq* – Abuse of a Muslim is evil

- Shouldn't abuse anyone or inflict harm on people
- Nazm: *Quran Sab Se Achhaa* – **third verse**
- Etiquettes of the mosque
 - Prayer for entering the mosque
 - When entering the mosque, greet the people inside the mosque: *Assalamualaikumwarahmatullah*– should also be for anyone you meet and when entering a house – with an appropriate volume.
 - Read 2 rakaatNafl prayer, *Tahiyyat-ul-Masjid*

Age 8:

- Quran: Parts 13 and 14 (read Surah 12:54)
 - *Maa* – not
 - *Ubarri-u-* to free from weakness
 - *Nafs*– self
 - *Ammaratun*– has a tendency; is prone to
 - *Soo'* – evil
 - *Ammaratun bi ssoo'l*– has a tendency to evil
 - *Rahimah*– to have mercy
 - *Khazaain*– treasure
 - *Hafeez* – Keeper
 - *Aleem*– knowledgable
- Start fasting during the month of Ramadan
- **Read at least one ruku a day everyday**
- Salat: **Surah Al-Fatiha with translation**
- **Memorize Surah Al-Baqarah verse 4**

Age 9:

- Quran: Surah Al-Baqarah verses 9-10 with word-by-word translation
- Have completed the first reading of the Holy Quran and have an Ameen ceremony

- 5 Pillars of Islam
 - o Kalima Shahadah –declaration of faith:
Ashhaduallaailaahailallahwaashhaduannamuhhammadan
'abduhuwarasooluh – I bear witness that there is no God but Allah, and I bear witness that Muhammad SAW is His Messenger
 - o Salat
 - o Zakat
 - o Fasting (Siyaam/Saum/Roza)
 - o Hajj
- Memorize Surah Al-Asr

Lutful Mannan Sahib (Age 10-14)

Age 10-13

- Make sure that Salat becomes part of our daily lives
- Salat: *As-Salatuimaaduddin* – Salat is a pillar of faith
- The importance of Salat
- Nazm: *Taran-e-Atfal*
 - o There is only One God, One Lord
 - o Who has created everything
 - o Who has no partner or father or sons
 - o Who is Eternal
 - o Who needs anything
 - o Who has the command over everything
 - o Who has provided everything such as water
- Life of Holy Prophet SAW (before prophethood – for 11-12 years; early life – for 10-11 years)
 - o Assa bin Qalaa – among the Holy Prophet SAW's ancestors who reestablished the ties among the Bani Ishmael and a great administrator

- Created 8 departments: among of which, one who gives the water for those who are doing pilgrimage
- BanuHaashim (his sons) – were assigned with the water duty
- The well of zamzam had been lost for a long period of time after it had been found by HadhratHaajira and Hadhrat Ismail, so Hadhrat Abdul Muttalib (the Holy Prophet SAW's grandfather) saw in a dream and started to find out where it is. People thought he was crazy, so he said that out of his sons who would grow up and he said he would sacrifice him. And he did find this well and another “earthly water” was discovered. So Hadhrat Abdul Muttalib earned so much respect from the Quraish.
- Lives of the Khulafa-ur-Rashiddeen
 - HadhratUmarFarooq RA 2ndKhalif
 - Farooq was his title
 - IbnKhattab – family life
 - Belonged to a noble family of Quraish
 - Renowned tradesman and often went to Syria and Iraq
 - Was a fierce opponent of Islam and one day took up a sword with the intention of killing the Holy Prophet SAW. Someone had told him that his sister had accepted Islam, and went to her and her husband instead. He beat his brother-in-law and wounded his sister who said that they will never change their religion. He calmed down and asked to hear the verses of the Quran. He was very moved and went to the Holy Prophet SAW's house and accepted Islam.
 - During his khilafat: Islam spread expansively after the conquests in the Middle East, was marked as a Golden Period, established a consultative body, established a financial department and schools and mosques in the various states, etc.
 - He used to go around in disguise to see if anyone was in need of help.
