- **Learn Surah Al-Fatiha**, part of Salat
 - o Listened to a recording with English and Urdu translation
- Review **Salat names and timings**

- Five obligatory prayers – essential and have been directed to offer during the day
 - Fajr – before dawn; 1 hour 23 minutes before sunrise; time to call Adhaan; until sunup
 - Zuhr–after zenith (when the sun is right above your head) until mid-afternoon
 - Asr – in the mid-afternoon until before (or right until) sunset
 - Maghrib – immediately after sunset
 - Isha – early evening until midnight (or until you go to sleep)
- Nawafil – optional prayers, not compulsory prayers
- Cannot read prayers when:
 - The sun is rising
 - The sun is at its zenith
 - The sun is sun setting
- Most beneficial time for Salat is the fixed time

Age 5

- Review Adhaan
 - Muedhin has done ablution, faces the Ka'aba and calls people to prayer loudly
 - Called for every obligatory prayer to mark the start time for the prayer
 - Call for Juma' prayer there are two:
 - One hour before the Juma' prayer to read Sunnah
 - Right before the Khutbah (Sermon) similar to the Iqaamat
 - Review the call to prayer's words
- Review Salat names

- Prayer to enter the mosque (can be found on English Waqf-e-Nau syllabus on page 10 - [http://www.waqfenau.us/english/Syllabus Waqfe Nau English Translation v08.pdf](http://www.waqfenau.us/english/Syllabus%20Waqfe%20Nau%20English%20Translation%20v08.pdf))
- Quran: reading Surah Al-Baqarahruku 4-5
- History of Islam: memorize names of Khulafa-e-Rashiddeen
- History of Ahmadiyya: memorize names of Khalifat-ul-Masih
- Know parents' names and grandparents' names

- Actively participate in Atfal-ul-Ahmadiyya and Nasirat-ul-Ahmadiyya activities
- Waaqif-e-Nau should try to go to the mosque with their fathers for the congregational prayers
- Quran (3:25-27): should start reading the 3rd part
 - o Pronunciation
 - o Letters: (2 categories based on how they are pronounced before ا ى)
 - Huruf-ul-Shamsiyyah
 - The letters that ا ى blend with the letters
 - When the ا ى is silent
 - Huruf-ul-Qamaariyyah
 - Pronounce the ا ى sound clearly

- Hadith: *SibaabulMuslimi...*
- Poem: *Quran Sab Se Achhaa* – memorize the 3rd verse
- Etiquettes of the mosque
 - Greet everyone by saying Assalamualaikum when entering
 - If possible, read two Nawafil prayer – Salat-ul-Tahiyyat-ul-Masjid

Age 8

- Quran: **Part 13 and 14** needs to be covered (12:57 was read in class)
 - Review Huruf-ul-Shamsiyyah and Huruf-ul-Qamaariyyah
 - **Memorization: 2:4**

Age 9

- Quran:
 - Have covered the entire Quran
 - **Understand the translation of 2:10-11**
 - **Memorize Surah Al-Asr**
- Basic Religious Knowledge
 - 5 Pillars of Islam
 - Kalima
 - Declaration of faith
 - *Ashhaduallaailaahaillallahuwaashhaduannamuhammad a-rasoolullah*
 - I bear witness that there is no God but Allah, and I bear worship that Muhammad^{SAW} is His messenger
 - We do not hide our faith, we declare it
 - We should follow Muhammad^{SAW}
 - Salat
 - 5 obligatory prayers – is food for the spirit
 - For purification like stream water to clean yourself

- Connection between you and God
- Zakat
 - Every year depending on the wealth, set aside a portion for the poor and the needy
 - Like a tax for a citizen
 - Only for wealthy people, not for the poor
 - Connection between you and other people (society)
- Fasting
 - Ramadan – should start at least fasting (this year: Aug. 21-Sept. 22)
- Hajj
 - Once in a lifetime if possible
 - Done during the month of Dhul-Hijra
 - Every Muslim gather around the Ka'aba to signify the Unity of Allah and the unity of mankind, all human beings are equal and belong to the same species
