Prayers at Meal Time

Abu Saeed Khudri informs us whenever the Holy Prophet^{sa} ate or drank he used to say these words:

الْحَمْدُ لِلَّهِ الَّذِي أَطْعَمَنَا وَسَقَانَا وَجَعَلَنَا مُسْلِمِينَ
 (Tirmidhi, Kitabud Da'awat)

All praise belongs to Allah, who fed us, gave us water to drink and made us from among the Muslims.

اللَّهُمَّ إِنِّي أَسْأَلُكَ خَيْرَ الْمَوْلِجِ، وَخَيْرَ الْمَخْرَجِ بِسْمِ اللَّهِ

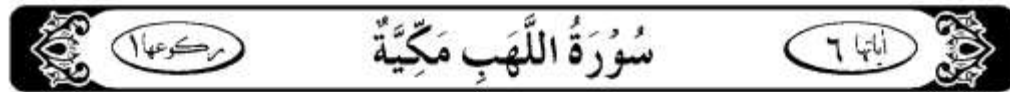
Recite *Bismillah* when getting into your car. Recite *Allahu Akbar* three times and then the following prayer.

Prayers of Sajdah-e-Tilawat

Wherever sajdah occurs in the verses of the Holy Qur'an prostration should be done. Wudhu is not obligatory nor is facing the Ka'ba. In prostration besides the words of glorification of God, repetition of these prayers is recorded in the traditions.

سَجْدٌ وَجْهِي لِلَّذِي خَلَقَهُ وَشَقَّ سَمْعَهُ وَبَصَرَهُ بِحَوْلِهِ وَ قُوَّتِهِ

(Tirmidhi, Kitabud Da'awat)

My face is in prostration for the Being, Who created it and with His special Divine power and strength bestowed upon me the faculty of hearing and seeing.
