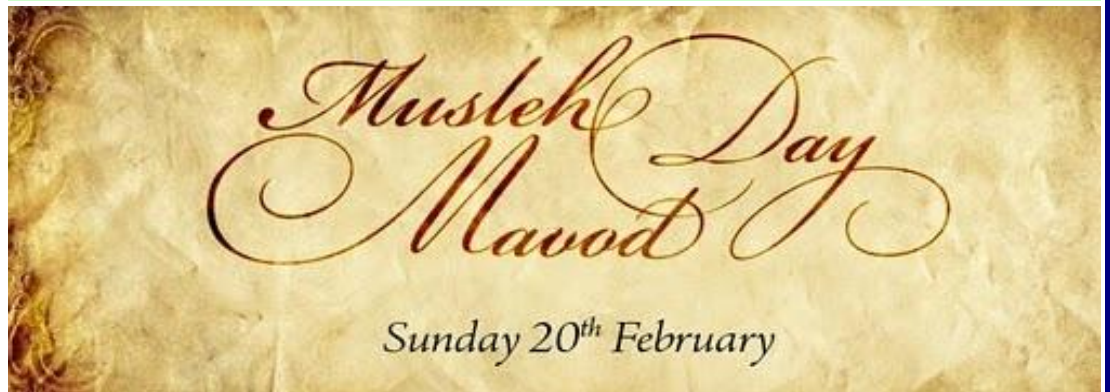
Hadhrat Khalifa-tul Masih IV^{rh} Said...

Absolute dedication and its reward: “Allah made it obligatory on the Holy Prophet^{saw} to acquaint his *slaves* (followers) with his certain qualities that were known only to Allah because they had a right to it, so that they may learn to reach Allah by following in his footsteps. One of these qualities was offering all that one had. It has been the way of the prophets that as they deliberate upon what else they should offer, they end up offering their children. Sometimes, they offer their children even before they were born, and this has been the tradition of the saints. We should also offer our yet to be born children as Waaqifeen in the cause of Allah, right now and we should pray, O Allah! Give us a son but if You have decreed to give us a daughter then we offer our daughter to You. *Ma fee batanee* (ما في بطني)- whatever is in my womb. This should be the prayer of the mothers and the fathers should pray in the words of Hadhrat Ibraheem^{as}: O Allah! Let our progeny be among Your elect servants so that they be entirely dedicated to You. **So that a magnificent army of Waaqifeen children, who are willing to relinquish this world, should enter the next century as the slaves of the God of Hadhrat Muhammad^{saw}, the Messenger of Allah.**

Holy Prophet^{saw}'s attribute of forgiveness

Delivered by Hadhrat Mirza Masroor Ahmad (at), the Head of the Ahmadiyya Muslim Community at Baitul Futuh Mosque, London on January 14th, 2011



Hudhur gave a discourse on the Holy Prophet's (peace and blessings of Allah be on him) attribute of forgiveness in today's Friday Sermon. He began by reciting the Quranic verse: **'Take to forgiveness, and enjoin kindness, and turn away from the ignorant.'** (7:200). Hudhur said when Hadhrat 'Aishah (may Allah be pleased with her) said that the Prophet's life was a representation of Quranic commandments, she identified the endless sea of high morals that he was and had thus indicated to search for precious pearls from this endless sea. His elevated station as the Seal of all the Prophets is apparent in the Divine statement of: **'...This day have I perfected your religion for you and completed My favour upon you and have chosen for you Islam as religion...'** (5:4) as God revealed

the last Book of religious law to him. Who could understand the Book more than him! Every aspect of his life was a practical depiction of the Holy Qur'an and a blessed model for us to follow. Today Hudhur chose to speak on his blessed quality of forgiveness. This quality enhanced the pious in their love for him, and highlighted the filth of the hypocrite when he forgave them.

The Promised Messiah (on whom be peace) wrote that people who are close to God have to experience terrible verbal abuse but they abide by: **'Take to forgiveness, and enjoin kindness, and turn away from the ignorant.'** The perfect man, the Prophet (peace and blessings of Allah be on him) was badly persecuted and verbally abused but this embodiment of forgiveness prayed for his enemies instead. In accordance with God's promise his detractors met the sorry end that was predicted for them and none could harm the Prophet's (peace and blessings of Allah be on him) honour. In spite of continuous persecution of himself and his Companions, when he attained power he demonstrated a peerless model of forgiveness. Any fair-minded historian could not deny that the Prophet's (peace and blessings of Allah be on him) attribute of forgiveness and fortitude was unequalled.

Abdullah ibn Abi bin Salool was the head of the hypocrites who appeared to obey the Prophet (peace and blessings of Allah be on him) but did not desist from making filthy attacks on him. The reason for his enmity was that the people of Medina were thinking of making him their leader but after the Prophet's (peace and blessings of Allah be on him) migration all the tribes and people of all religions accepted him as the leader instead. In an incident before the battle of Badr, the quality of forgiveness of the Prophet (peace and blessings of Allah be on him) shone through.

The Holy Prophet (peace and blessings of Allah be on him) was going to see Sa'ad bin Ubada who was unwell. Along the way he passed by an assembly in which Abdullah bin Salool sat along with Muslims, idol-worshippers and Jews. As the Prophet's

(peace and blessings of Allah be on him) ride passed by some dust flew on the assembly. Abdullah Salool covered his nose and said 'do not throw dust on us'. In response, the Prophet (peace and blessings of Allah be on him) said his greetings and read some Qur'an to them. Abdullah Salool said, 'do not bother us, go home and read the Qur'an to whoever comes to your home.' A Companion who was present said, 'O Prophet of God, come and read the Qur'an to us in our gatherings.' People stood up and an argument ensued. The Prophet asked them to quieten down and left. After a while Abdullah Salool became a Muslim but troubled the Prophet (peace and blessings of Allah be on him) through his hypocritical schemes.



During one expedition a migrant (Makkan Muslim) struck an Ansar's back with his hand. The Ansar retaliated. Both of them started calling their people for help. Seeing this, the Prophet (peace and blessings of Allah be on him) stopped them from reverting to ignorant times. When Abdullah Salool came to know of this he reacted aggressively in front of the Holy Prophet (peace and blessings of Allah be on him). Hadhrat Umer (may Allah be pleased with him), who was present, stood up and asked the Holy Prophet (peace and blessings of Allah be on him) if he could cut the man's head off for the insolence. The

Prophet (peace and blessings of Allah be on him) replied, 'forgive him for people may say that Muhammad even kills his associates.'

The Holy Prophet (peace and blessings of Allah be on him) heard that Abdullah Salool had said something disagreeable so he asked him for confirmation. He denied and the Prophet did not ask him again. However, God informed the Prophet (peace and blessings of Allah be on him) through revelation that what he had heard was true. It is thus recorded in the Qur'an: **'They say, 'If we return to Medina, the one most honorable will surely drive out therefrom the one most mean;'** (63:9).

This left no doubt about what had happened even though the Prophet (peace and blessings of Allah be on him) already perceived Abdullah Salool to be so. [[more](#)]

Hadhrat Mirza Bashir-ud-Din Mahmud Ahmad (1889-1965)

Khalifatul Masih II [1914-1965](Second Successor to the Promised Messiah) and Al Musleh Mau`ood (The Promised Reformer)

Hadhrat Mirza Bashiruddin Mahmood Ahmad (Allah be pleased with him) received his education in the District Board Primary School and, later in 1898, in Taleemul Islam High School when it was started.

Nevertheless, in his student life he was never interested in routine book knowledge, and could not succeed in the Government Entrance Examination. This was the end of his formal education, which was not merely incidental, but a great miracle of the Divine Destiny. Incidents later proved that the Lord Almighty Himself wanted to be his teacher. Thus the world witnessed that he not only had intrinsic and spiritual knowledge but his insight into basic wisdom was so vast and deep that, however, learned a scholar, armed with whatever worldly knowledge attacked Islam he would prove to be a mere academic novice. Thus the fulfillment of the divine revelation became manifest.

The Divine Revelation Concerning the Musleh Mau`ood

In the announcement of February 20, 1886, the Promised Messiah, peace be on him, says:

"God the Merciful, the Noble, the High, the Exalted, Who has power to do all that He wills (glory be to Him and exalted be His name), has vouchsafed to me the following revelation:

"I confer upon thee a Sign of My mercy according to thy supplications. I have heard thy entreaties and have honored thy prayers with My acceptance through My mercy and have blessed this thy journey. A sign of power, mercy, nearness to Me is bestowed on thee. A Sign of grace and beneficence is awarded to thee and thou art granted the key of success and victory. Peace on thee, O victorious one. Thus does God speak so that those who desire life may be rescued from the grip of death and those who are buried in the graves may emerge therefrom and so that the superiority of Islam and the dignity of God's word may become manifest unto the people and so that the truth may arrive with all its blessings and falsehood may depart with all its ills, and so that people may understand that I am the Lord of Power, I do whatever I will, and so that they may believe that I am with thee, and so that those who do not believe in God and deny and reject His religion and His Book and His Holy Messenger Muhammad, the chosen one (on whom be peace) may be confronted with a clear sign and the way of the guilty ones may become manifest.

"Rejoice, therefore, that a handsome and pure boy will be bestowed on thee. Thou wilt receive a bright youth who will be of thy seed and will be of thy progeny. A handsome and pure boy will come as your guest. His name is Emmanuel and Bashir. He has been invested with a holy spirit and he will be free from all impurity. He is the light of Allah. Blessed is he who comes from heaven. He shall be accompanied by grace (*Fazl*) which shall arrive with him. He will be characterized with grandeur, greatness and wealth. He will come into the world and will heal many of their disorder through his Messianic qualities and through the blessings of the Holy Spirit. He is the Word of Allah for Allah's mercy and honor have equipped him with the Word of Majesty. He will be extremely intelligent and understanding and will be meek of heart and will be filled with secular and spiritual knowledge. He will convert three into four (of this the meaning is not clear). It is Monday, a blessed Monday. Son, delight of heart, high ranking, noble; a manifestation of the First and the Last, a manifestation of the True and the High; as if Allah has descended from heaven. His advent will be greatly blessed and will be a source of manifestation of Divine Majesty. Behold! a light cometh, a light anointed by God with the perfume of His pleasure. We shall pour our spirit into him and he will be sheltered under the shadow of God. He will grow rapidly in stature and will be the means of procuring the release of those held in bondage. His fame will spread to the ends of the earth and peoples will be blessed through him. He will then be raised to his spiritual station in heaven. This is a matter decreed."

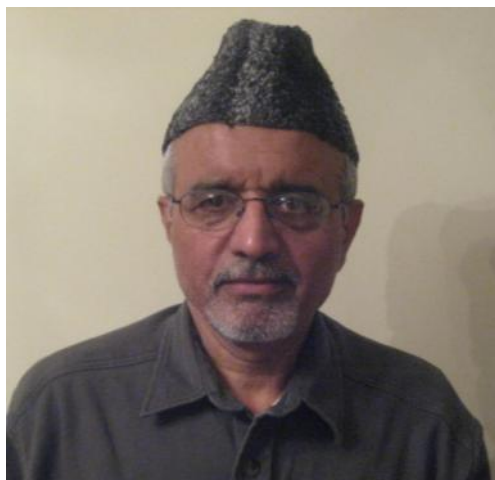
First course of recitation of the Holy Quran finished by Hisham Ahmad
